

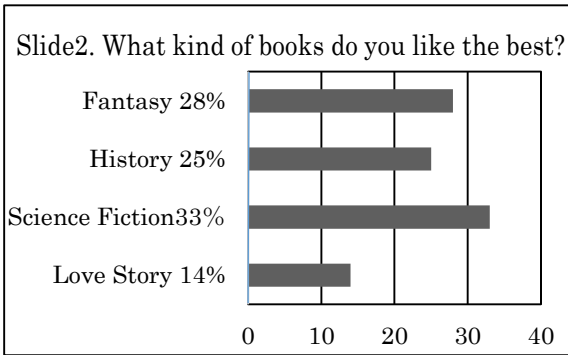

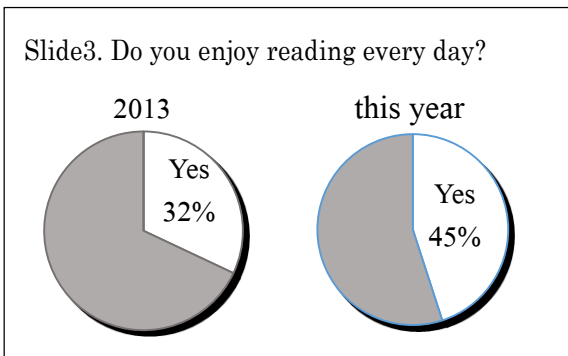
Slide1. How many students borrow books from the library?

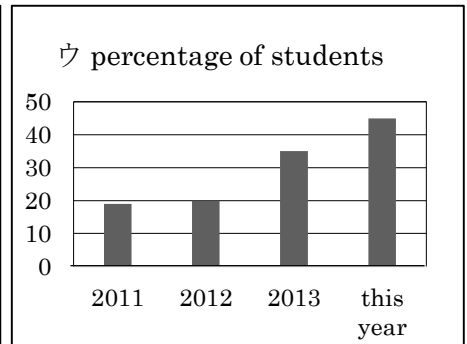
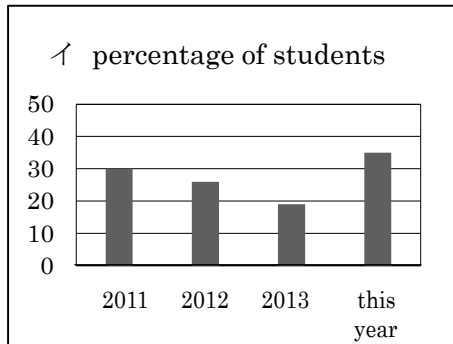
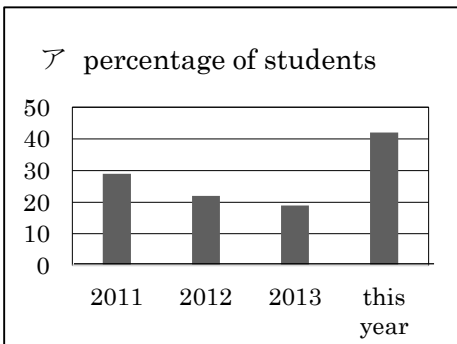

Our Earth is a beautiful blue planet  white places in the north and the south. There are also brown and green places on the Earth. But most of it is blue, because about three-quarters of it is water, seas of water. The large white places are ice, the Arctic in the north, and the Antarctic in the south. Ninety percent of the world's ice is in the Antarctic. When you stand on the ice in the Antarctic, there are about four kilometers of ice under your feet. This ice is fresh water, but the seas are salty. This is important because we can't live  fresh water. We can't drink water from the sea.

There is a lot of water on the Earth. There are rivers and lakes. There is rain too. But let's think about it. If we put all the world's water into a hundred very big glasses, ninety-seven of those glasses would have salt water from the seas in them. We would only have three glasses of fresh water. Two of these three glasses would be ice from the north and the south. That leaves only one glass. More than half of the water in that glass is under the ground, and much of the other water is not clean. So, .

This doesn't change — there is no 'new' water. Every year there are about 80,000,000 more people on our Earth and they all need clean, fresh water. Today, about 10% of the people in the world don't have enough water. By 2025, some people say, it will be 35%. The biggest problems now are in Africa and the Middle East. It is so dry in these countries because they don't have much rain. But India, Pakistan and China have other problems. These countries have many people and they are trying to make plans for the future. We don't need water only for people in their homes, of course. Farms and factories use a lot of water. They need more water than homes. ④People need not only water but also work.

The use of water in the world goes up each year by about 3%, and the number of people in the world goes up by between 1% and 2%. Some countries are using 4%—8% more water every year. Pollution is another big problem. Cities, farms and factories are all polluting the fresh water in rivers and lakes. People can't drink the water from them because the water is dangerous for their health. ⑤This will have to stop. Everybody needs water. How can we make the world a better place? We have to think carefully and act quickly.
