



Washoku, "traditional Japanese food" is now disappearing from our dining tables. As Japanese people's lifestyles change, fast food restaurants and convenience stores have spread all over Japan. Eating out with the family has become an everyday event, and meals at home have greatly changed.

Originally, "Japanese food" may not be a word that just means dishes. Take, for example, the New Year's *osechi ryori* and *ozoni*. These dishes are filled with wishes for a happy and healthy new year. In other words, (⑤) <u>Japanese ways of thinking are expressed in the Japanese food</u>.

Food culture has developed from the natural environment around us and the unique culture of the country or region. Japan's food culture has evolved under the *influence of Chinese, *Korean, Southeast Asian, and more recently, Western culture.

Japanese food has a long history of (V) taking in new things such as fried chicken, omelets, and spaghetti. Japanese people have developed their own food culture and each region of Japan has created dishes unique to its local environment. The dishes and ways of eating have also changed from age to age and from region to region. You can enjoy many kinds of Japanese dishes all over Japan.

However, the dishes on our tables seem a little different these days. In 1965, Japanese food *self-sufficiency rate was about 80%, but it went down to 40% in 2012. This is caused by changes in Japanese way of eating. As fewer Japanese families are eating rice, "Japanese food" is (5).

Today, many people think the future of *washoku* is in danger. According to the survey, "To make local dishes, we are using less local material and more *imported vegetables." In addition, there were a large number of responses, such as "More children cannot hold chopsticks in the correct way," "More young people do not say '*itadakimasu*' before meals," and "*Washoku* manners are not *conveyed to the younger generation."

We should protect Japanese food just as we want to protect nature. Japanese food is an important part of the culture that has kept people healthy and connected with each other. Nowadays, Japanese food is accepted as one of the best food in the world, and we should be proud of it and convey it to the next generation.

The Problems of The High Seas

The UN and its members have agreed to protect the High Seas. The High Seas is *two-thirds of the world's oceans. All countries have a right to use the seas. However, only about 1% of these areas is protected from overfishing and shipping traffic. So, a lot of fish and other sea animals are dying.

Kim : I think that the most serious problem now is plastic pollution. We should reduce single use plastics — plastic bags, plastic bottles and fishing tools — because they break down into smaller pieces and sea animals eat them.
